How a nuclear attack would affect you...

Huddersfield, being a major engineering and chemicals manufacturing centre, could be a target.

- FIRE: In the inner ring the whole of Huddersfield from Outlane to Kirkheaton would catch fire. The heat in this area would be enough to melt metal. Six miles out the heat would set light to rubber and plastic...and people. Anyone in Leeds and Manchester looking our way would be blinded.
- **BLAST**: This would create a 600mph wind. Houses, the main hospitals and fire services would vanish.
- **FALLOUT**: A one-megaton explosion over Huddersfield would kill between 100,000 and 150,000 people immediately. Many thousands more would die slowly and in agony due to fallout. In the long term there would be cancers, leukaemia and birth defects.
