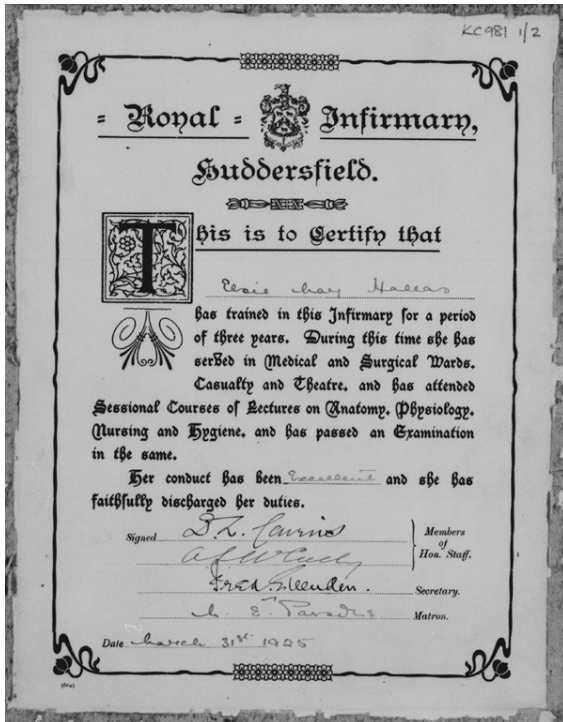
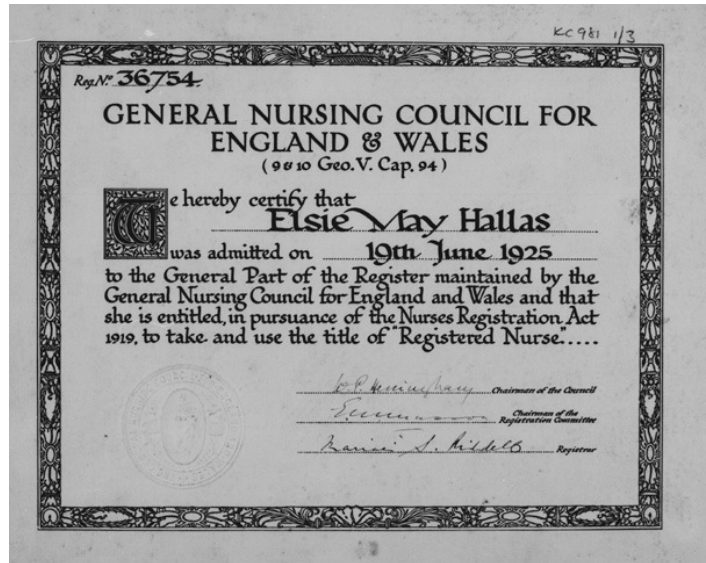


Elsie Harling – Source 1

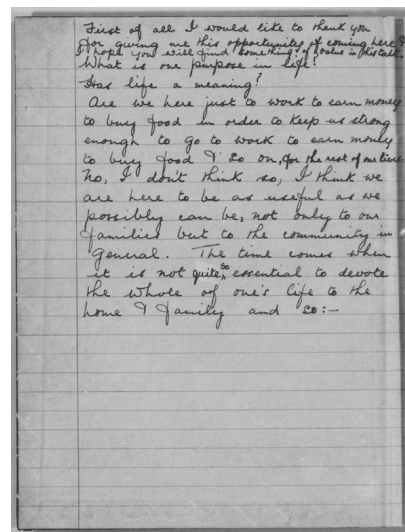
Elsie Harling was a nurse and voluntary worker from Dalton, Huddersfield. The records on the History to Her Story website include memoirs of her nursing career.
