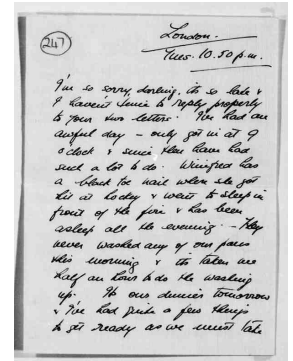


Amy Johnson – Worksheet 2
