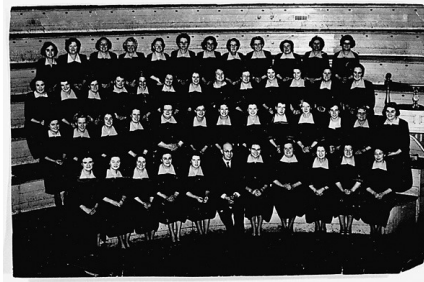

## Fenton Ladies Choir – Worksheet 1



### Glossary:

**Rubato** = flexible, not in strict time or on the beat.

**Fortissimo** = very loud and strong

**Allargando** = gradually slowing down the speed/tempo of singing

**Vigorous** = energetic

**Precision** = accurately, being exact.
